Sixth Grade Course Descriptions

Art 6

Art 6 is for all students. Throughout the year, students will create interesting art projects in many kinds of art media. Emphasis is on projects that are fun, skill developing, and integrated with core subjects.

Band 6

A second-year band course focused on expanding individual skills along with the challenge of playing together in a large group. This class meets two times per week and is intended for students who have completed one year of band instruction.

Choir 6

This course offers a large-group choral experience for any interested student. Emphasis is given to developing vocal technique and the enjoyment of singing. This class meets one time per week.

CSI Medicine & Space 6

This exciting course is an introduction to the worlds of aerospace, medicine, and computer science, while also challenging students to work with their hands. Students will design, build, and test an airfoil. They will solve real-life medical mysteries with DNA evidence. They will also learn introductory programming skills through a series of fun interactive challenges. This class meets two times per week.

Math Lab 6

This is a course taken in addition to the student's regular mathematics class to support those students needing additional support with mathematical concepts and skills as they enter the sixth grade (by teacher/parent recommendation and/or assessment).

Orchestra 6

A second-year string course focused on expanding individual skills along with the challenge of playing together in a large group. This class meets two times per week and is intended for students who have completed one year of orchestra.

Physical Education 6

This class provides a variety of recreational fitness and skill-building activities that promote teamwork, sportsmanship, and life-long physical fitness.

Spanish 6

Students will increase their knowledge and develop greater proficiency in comprehension, speaking, reading and writing Spanish in a meaningful and interdisciplinary context. Students will also continue their study of Hispanic culture. This class meets two times per week.
